

The Curriculum Framework for Children and Young People with Vision Impairment (CFVI)

The Curriculum Framework for Children and Young People with Vision Impairment (CFVI) is a UK wide framework that supports children and young people with vision impairment aged 0 – 25 to access an appropriate and equitable education. It is referenced in all reports from the VI Team although how it is used will vary according to levels of need.

The CFVI has 11 areas of learning, such as facilitating an inclusive world, independent living skills, mobility, accessing information, sport, social communication and preparing for adulthood. It enhances the education experiences of children and young people with a shared language and guidance on best practice to achieve the very best outcomes for children and young people with a VI.
