

After listening to NRS's heritage expert waxing lyrically about how nice the site will be when restored to open parkland I felt it needed to be stated that the land will revert to the owners afterwards . On past form they will either fence it into paddocks or look for some money making scheme ,wind/solar farm or housing. I'm also dubious about the restoration. I purchased some similar sandy land in Wolverley 6 years ago & attempted to restore a 100 metre hedgerow. I planted 300 mixed British hedging bushes & left it . Virtually all died. The next year I replaced it all & watered weekly. I still lost a lot ,so I now water 3 times a week in warm weather. I found out that only hawthorn & blackthorn do any good. Even so I will still have to replace 30 bushes this year . Will NRS or the owner be so dedicated. I very much doubt it.

Hopefully it will never be put to the test
