- 1. That Worcestershire County Council (The County of Worcestershire (Various Roads, Offenham) (40 Mph Speed Limit) Order 2000 (Revocation) (The County of Hereford and Worcester (Various Roads, Offenham Cross) (40 M.P.H Speed Limit) (No. 3) Order 1992 (Revocation) and (Various Roads, Offenham, Badsey and Aldington) (40 Mph Speed Limit) Order 2016 (Revocation) and (Various Roads, Offenham) (40 Mph Speed Limit) Order 2023) is hereby revoked in its entirety.
- 2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along those lengths of roads specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order.
- No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along those lengths of roads specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 5. This Order may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (Various Roads and B4510, Offenham) (30 MPH and 40 MPH Speed Limit) (Proposals and Revocation) Order 2025 and shall come into operation on XXXX 2025.

Description of the map

The map shows the proposed 30mph and 40mph Speed Limit zone to on Various Roads and B4510 **Offenham:**

30mph Speed Limit:

B4510 (Newtown/Evesham Road): From a point 40 metres north of its junction with U45200 (Three Cocks Lane) in a southerly then south westerly direction to a point 158 metres north of its junction with C2047 (Station Road)/U45206 (Laurels Road).

C2047 (Station Road): From a point 50 metres southeast of its junction with B4510 (Evesham Road) for 430 metres in a south easterly direction.

U45207 (Merry Lane): From its junction with C2050 (Bennetts Hill) for 40 metres in a southerly direction.

U45200 (Three Cocks Lane): From its junction with B4510 (Newtown) for 690 metres in a south westerly direction.


C2050 (Bennetts Hill): From its junction with B4510 (Evesham Road) to a point 470 metres west of its junction with B4085 (Station Road, South Littleton).


The following sections of road will revert to 30mph by virtue of street lighting: B4510 (Evesham Road): From its junction with C2047 (Station Road)/U45206 (Laurels Road) for 260 metres in a southerly direction and 158 metres in a northerly direction. U45206 (Laurels Road): From its junction with B4510 (Evesham Road) for 55 metres in a north westerly direction.

C2047 (Station Road): From its junction with B4510 (Evesham Road) for 50 metres in a southeasterly direction.

40mph Speed Limit:

B4510 (Offenham Road): From a point 260 metres south of its junction with C2047 (Station Road)/U45206 (Laurels Road) in a southerly direction to a point 105 metres north of its junction with B4510 roundabout (leading to Codling Road).

- No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along those roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- This Order may be cited as Worcestershire County Council The County of Worcestershire (Various Roads, Offenham) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2000 (Revocation)The County Of Hereford And Worcester (Various Roads, Offenham Cross) (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 3) Order 1992 (Revocation) And (Various Roads, Offenham, Badsey and Aldington) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2016 (Revocation) and (Various Roads, Offenham) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2023 and shall come into operation on 26 October 2023

From its junction with C2050 (Bennetts Hill) for a distance of 40 metres in a southerly direction.

U45200 (Three Cocks Lane):

From its junction with B4510 (Newtown) for a distance of 690 metres in a south westerly direction.

C2050 (Bennetts Hill):

From its junction with B4510 (Evesham Road) to a point 470 metres west of its junction with B4085 (Station Road, South Littleton).
