- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall cause any vehicle the width of which, inclusive of any load on the vehicle, exceeds 6'6" (2 metres) to proceed in the lengths of roads in the Parish of Emley Lovett in the District of Wychavon in the County of Worcestershire specified in the Schedule to this order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of roads specified in that Article if the vehicle is being used:
 - a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the said lengths of roads.
 - for the purposes of agriculture in connection with and adjacent to the lengths of roads or tor the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land.

 - f) for the purpose of a universal service provider (as defined in Section 65 of the Postal Services Act 2011) to be used for the purpose of delivering and/or collecting mail.



- Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause any vehicle the width of which, inclusive of any load on the vehicle, exceeds two metres to proceed in that length of C2145 Sneads Green to Elmley Lovett Road in the Parish of Elmley Lovett in the District of Wychavon in the County of Mereford and Worcester which extends from its junction with C2146 road to its junction with C2144 road at Coach Hill
- Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in that Article if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the said length of road;
 - (b) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to the length of road or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land;
 - (c) in connection with any building or industrial operation or demolition in or adjacent to the said length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, or the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (d) vehicles when being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (e) mechanical road cleansing vehicles;
 - (f) for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953.

- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of roads specified in that Article if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the said lengths of roads;
 - (b) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to the lengths of roads or for the conveyance or heulage of timber felled upon that land;
 - (c) in connection with any building or industrial operation or demolition in or adjacent to the said lengths of roads, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, or the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of roads or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the said lengths of roads of any sever or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (d) vehicles when being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (e) mechanical road cleansing vehicles;
 - (f) for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953.

This Order may be cited as The County of Hereford and Morcester (Crown Lane (East), Sneads Green Lane and Ryelands Lane, Elmley Lovett) (Width Restriction) Order 1989 and shall come into operation on the 7th March 1989.
