

# TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ACT 2004

## Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme Order 2019

Made: 11th April 2019

Coming into force: 20<sup>th</sup> May 2019

**WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL** hereby makes an Order under Part 3 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the Act") whereby acting as the Local Highway Authority it revokes the Order known as "the Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme Order " made on the 11<sup>th</sup> February 2016 in exercise of the powers conferred by the Act and makes a new Order to be known as 'The Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme Order 2019'. The purpose of this Order is to give effect to modifications to the Permit Scheme since it was made in 2016.

### **Interpretation** In this Order -

"The Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme 2019" means the Permit Scheme prepared in accordance with Section 33A of the Traffic Management Act 2004 (as amended) set out in the Schedule to this Order in which has been approved by the Council, comprising of the common regional scheme in use in the West Midlands region "The West Shires Permit Scheme" and a local addendum for Worcestershire known as "Application Annex for Worcestershire County Council to operate the West and Shires Permit Scheme"

"Specified streets" has the meaning given by Regulation 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 (as amended)

The Order may be cited as 'The Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme Order 2019' and comes into effect in relation to the specified streets within the Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme 2019 on 20<sup>th</sup> May 2019.

### Commencement of The Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme 2019

1. The Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme 2019 comes into effect on 20<sup>th</sup> May 2019.

### **Application of Part 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 (as amended)**

2. Part 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 (as amended) shall apply to the specified streets within the Worcestershire County Council Permit Scheme 2019
