- 1. That The County of Worcestershire (Various Roads, Bredon's Hardwick) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2000 is hereby revoked in its entirety.
- 2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along those roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 4. This Order may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (Various Roads, Bredon's Hardwick) (40 MPH Speed Limit) (Proposal and Revocation) Order 2025 and shall come into operation on XXXXX 2025

C2272 Hardwick Bank Road: from its junction with B4080 for a distance of 90 metres in an easterly direction.

UC46217 Bredon's Hardwick Lane: for its entire length.
