- 4. This Order may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (Winchcombe Road, Sedgeberrow) (30 mph Speed Limit) (Revocation and Proposal) Order 2025 and shall come into operation on 10 July 2025.

Map of Winchcombe Road, Sedgeberrow and the **30mph speed limit zone** implemented by the above order



#### (RESTRICTED ROADS) (NO. 1) ORDER 1989

Hereford and Worcester County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby direct as follows:-

- That length of Winchcombe Road in the Parish of Sedgeberrow in the District of Wychavon in the County of Hereford and Worcester which extends from its junction with Main Street for a distance of 503 metres (1650 feet) in a southerly direction shall become a restricted road for the purpose of Section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984;
- This Order may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (Restricted Roads) (No. 1) Order 1989 and shall come into operation on the 7th day of November 1989.
