PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2022

Order Preliminaries

This Order is made by Worcestershire County Council ('the authority') under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ('the 1980 Act') because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath and described in paragraph 1 of this order, it is expedient that the line of the footpath should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ('the 1981 Act'') because it appears to the authority that the County of Worcestershire definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

The applicant has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public ('the works to the new site').

Wychavon District Council have been consulted about the making of the Order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

Articles

Bv this Order:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situated at White Ladies Aston and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this order, and thereupon the County of Worcestershire definitive map and statement shall be modified accordingly.
- 2. Notwithstanding this Order any statutory undertaker as shall for the time being have statutory powers in that respect shall have the right to open up the land referred to in paragraph 1 to install, maintain or alter their apparatus.
- 3. There shall on the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situated in White Ladies Aston described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this Order, and thereupon the County of Worcestershire definitive map and statement shall be modified accordingly

- 4. The County of Worcestershire definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the schedule of this Order.
- 5. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

FOOTPATH WL-501 (PART)(FORMERLY FOOTPATH No. 1) IN THE PARISH OF WHITEE LADIES ASTON

The length and entire width of footpath WL-501 (part) in the parish of White Ladies Aston to be diverted commences at Ordnance Survey grid reference (OSGR) SO 9141 5303 (Point A on the Order map) the footpath proceeds in a south-south-easterly direction for 28 metres, then turns in a south-westerly direction for 32 metres to terminate at OSGR SO 9140 5298 (Point B on the Order map).

The total distance of the footpath to be diverted is 60 metres.

Description of Site of New Footpath

FOOTPATH WL-501 (PART) (FORMERLY FOOTPATH No. 1) IN THE PARISH OF WHITE LADIES ASTON

The length of footpath WL-501 (part) in the parish of White Ladies Aston commences with a width of 2 metres at Ordnance Survey grid reference (OSGR) SO 9141 5303 (Point A on the Order map) the footpath proceeds in a south-westerly direction for 42 metres to terminate at the highway U43003 Edwards Lane at OSGR SO 9138 5300 (Point C on the Order map).

The total distance of the diverted footpath is 42 metres.

FOOTPATH WL-501 (PART) (FORMERLY FOOTPATH No. 1) IN THE PARISH OF WHITE LADIES **ASTON** Parish of White Ladies Aston District of Pershore Wychavon 501 (part) (formerly No.1) **CLASSIFICATION:** Footpath LOCATION: Commencing on parish boundary 400 yards west of Churchill Wood Farm, being a continuation of Footpath No. 3 in Churchill Parish, path proceeds south alongside boundary to cross Footpath No. 2 and join Sneachill - White Ladies Aston Road 625 594 yards south east of The Berkeley Knot Inn. Diverted under HA 1980 section 119 2022 Length 69 miles 1080 metres 1.08 kilometres **DESCRIPTION General:** Parish boundary (F), south following Parish Boundary and eastern boundary hedge of ploughed field (O.S. Plot No. 4) - no track - to meet field gate and fence for stile (G). By eastern boundary hedge of pasture field (O.S. Plot No. 4) to meet wicket gate (H). [NOTE: On south side of wicket gate then is a boggy patch 11 yards wide]. Footpath crosses arable field (O.S. Plot No. 6) over Footpath No. 2 (Y) to meet gap (J), continuing south by 8 foot wide grass cart track following Parish boundary and eastern edge of ploughed field, (O.S. Plot No. 33) to meet gap (K) in line with fruit trees (no hedge). Path follows 8 foot grass track by eastern boundary hedge of ploughed field (O.S. Plot No. 34), to pedestrian gate in hedge at OSGR SO 9141 5303 then bears south west over 2 metre wide grass track for a few yards 42 metres before meeting road at stile (L) pedestrian gate at OSGR SO 9138 5300.
