PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2025

The above Order, made on 4th of September 2025 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert the public footpath, and modify the definitive map and statement for Worcestershire accordingly:

From: a line running from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SP 0142 5332 (point A on the order plan) in a northeasterly direction for 44 metres to OSGR SP 0144 5336 (point B on the order plan). To: a line running from OSGR SP 0142 5332 (point A on the order plan). The footpath proceeds in a northeasterly direction for 3 metres to OSGR SP 0142 5332 (point C on the order plan) before turning to the north northeast for 8 metres, to OSGR SP 0142 5333 (point D on the order plan). The footpath then passes alongside a building, in a northeasterly direction, for 34 metres to rejoin the original footpath route at OSGR SP 0144 5336 (point B on the order plan).
